LAUNCHING TELEHEALTH SYSTEM AT THE LE HUU TRAC NATIONAL BURN HOSPITAL

"Breaking the distance" is what the Remote Medical Examination Treatment Project brings through the Telehealth connection system. It is a big step forward when technology is strongly applied in domestic medicine. On December 24, Le Huu Trac National Burn Hospital/Military Medical Academy held the opening ceremony of the Telehealth system, under the project of medical remote examination and treatment for the period 2020-2025.

Attending the ceremony were Major General, Prof. Dr. Hoang Van Luong, Deputy Director of Military Medical Academy, representative of the Ministry of Health; representatives of the leadership of the Military Medical Department, the Board of Directors of the National Burn Hospital Le Huu Trac; Mr. Ngo Vinh Quy, Deputy General Director of Viettel Business Solutions Company and 27 hospitals that are the demand points in the country for online monitoring via telehealth system.

Speaking at the opening ceremony of the Colonel's Ceremony, Assoc.Prof.Dr. Nguyen Nhu Lam, Deputy Director of the Hospital said: "The implementation of telemedicine at present reflects the direction of the Prime Minister and the Ministry of Health on social distancing, is one of the important solutions contributing to the prevention and control of the complicated development of the COVID-19 epidemic, reducing the overload of upperlevel hospitals, and having many benefits for patients and medical facilities", namely:

- Contributing to improving the quality of medical examination and treatment efficiency of lower-level hospitals.
 - Limit patient visits to medical facilities
- Strengthening medical examination and treatment at lower levels, does not transfer patients to higher levels in case the diseases at lower levels cannot be treated.
- People enjoy good and highly specialized medical services in their own localities, contributing to reducing treatment costs, reducing disease burden, creating trust and peace of mind for patients.

Le Huu Trac National Burn Hospital is a specialized hospital of the last line, assigned by the Ministry of Health and the Military Medical Department to direct the line on burns for military and civil medicine hospitals throughout the country. For many years, Le Huu Trac National Burn Hospital has actively applied information technology in directing the line, providing remote professional support, and providing remote advice (establishing medical maintaining a medical department). remote medical examination and treatment at the Hospital). Participation in this project is a new step in the hospital's medical examination and treatment and it is expected to be widelv applied consultation, training and directing activities of the Hospital. In the past time, as a hospital specializing in burns, plastic burn sequelae, surgery. and wound healing, through this project, the hospital has had many activities to contribute to improving the capacity of examination and treatment. The disease is not only for patients at the Hospital but also supports many units in all regions of the country.
